1. Inter-Library Loan and Resource Sharing:

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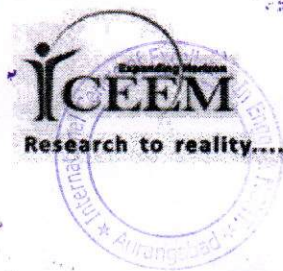



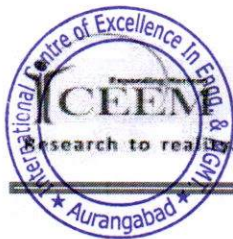

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Electoral Literacy Club


